 12. Give thanks for all who donated to the Backpack Buddies effort. Pray that each child who receives a new backpack would know that they have a heavenly Father who loves them more than they could know or imagine.
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13. There is an OCC work bee today. Pray that God would continue to bless the work of the hands of the many volunteers. Pray that God would raise up more folks to help with this important ministry.
 14. Pray that God would raise up more Community Group leaders this fall so that everyone who would like to participate would find a place.
